### What is RSS?

RSS (Really Simple Syndication) is an XML-based Web standard that allows you to display the latest headlines from your favorite websites using special programs called RSS readers (also news readers, news aggregators) and then directly access the articles you wish to see. The STAT!Ref Evidence Alerts RSS feed delivers information from the latest updates in STAT!Ref Evidence Alerts and links back to the EBM updates you selected to receive.

### How do I use RSS?

To use RSS you can use your browser's bookmarks. If your browser does not have this capability, download an RSS reader that will allow you to collect and display RSS feeds. Many free readers are available. Search the Web for "news aggregator" or "RSS reader" to locate a reader to download. Please follow your specific RSS reader's instructions for setting up an RSS Feed.
