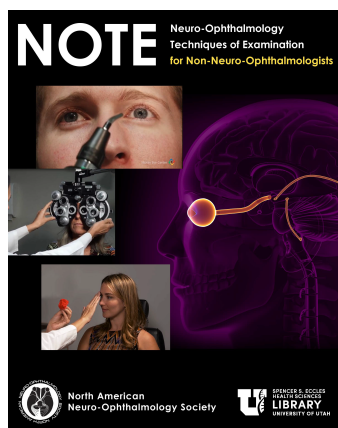




NANOS NOTE (Neuro-Ophthalmology Techniques of Examination) for NON-neuroophthalmologists
